A graduate of Wentworth Institute of Technology as an Experimental Machinist and Tool Maker, Ray Daniels has over 35-years of diverse industry experience as a Designer of every aspect of Fire Alarm and Fire Suppression systems. He has been a member of NFPA since 1977 and is a past member of the Massachusetts Fire Chief Association, Massachusetts Fire Marshals Association, RI Fire Marshal's Association, and the New England Fire Marshals Association.

Having aided the State of Rhode Island with the exams which are administered for Portable Fire Extinguishers, Hydro-Testing and Fire Suppression, and the Pipe Fitters licensing, Mr. Daniels has also taught distributors throughout the United States and Canada.
